All India Brahmin Federation (AIBF), the apex body of all Brahmin organizations, associations in India had three days national event at the holy town of Tirupathi at the lotus feet of Lord Sri Venkateswara Swamy from 20th to 22nd December 2014.

On the first day, both National Executive Council and General Body meetings were held at Hotel Bliss, Tirupathi under the presidentship of Pt. Bhavarlal Sharma, President, AIBF, who is also a MLA from Rajasthan. AIBF thank wholeheartedly Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu for establishing AP state Brahmin Welfare Corporation for the welfare of poor Brahmins in India. Also recently the decision of increasing the wages of Priests to Rs. 5000 per month by allocating Rs.250 Crores is welcomed. Six resolutions were passed unanimously by the General Body of AIBF. Swachh Bharath, Make in India and Fight against terrorism are the three vital subjects which have drawn attention in the national meeting of AIBF.

1. It is resolved to extend whole hearted support in making Swachh Bharath a grand success and consistently work for its success as it is a ever lasting program.

2. It is resolved to undertake Make in India program effectively and explore possibilities of marketing abroad through the NRI Brahmins and Brahmin organizations located worldwide.

3. Fight against terrorism is the need of the hour and it is resolved to have unending efforts to fight terrorism in whichever shape it is. Both Internal and external terrorism will have to be tackled effectively and we appeal all our Brahmin brethren to fight this menace.

4. It is resolved to implement 3 E program (Education, Employment and Empowerment) nation wide for the welfare of Brahmin community in India.

5. It is also resolved to voice our protects in state and central governments and demand to stop discrimination against Brahmins in India.

On Sunday, 21st December, with the association of Transform India Foundation, a seminar on total eradication of untouchability was organized at Mahathi Auditorium, Tirupathi. The main purpose of the seminar was to eradicate untouchability totally in India as we believe that all human beings are equal in the eyes of god and no one is untouchable. This social evil should not disturb the society and the Brahmins throughout the nation from Kashmir to Kanyakumari will drive out the devil untouchability for ever. The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. K. Rosiah, His Excellency the Governor of Tamil Nadu, Justice Jasti Chalmeswar Rao, Hon'ble Justice of Supreme Court, Justice K. Chandrabhanu, Hon'ble Judge of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana High Court, AIBF President Pt.
